This year we've made some changes to the rules so as to make it more competitive for everyone.

Program Awards & Trophies

High Overall

One of the big changes is that the Grand will be used as a determining factor for all year-end buckles not just the handicap. The Grand will shoot the same number of targets as last year, 50 singles, 50 handicap and 25 pairs of doubles and will also be used for averages.

Handicap: 4 Groups
 (26-27, 24-25, 22-23, 18-21)

Winners of an award, as in the past, will move up in classification or in yardage, but will only be required to maintain that classification or yardage for six shoots instead of eight shoots before returning to current rolling average.

Doubles: 5 Classes
 (AA, A, B, C & D)

Rolling averages will still be best five of the last eight shoots, but the Grand can and will be included as one of the eight.

Singles: 5 Classes
 (AA, A, B, C & D)

Late shooters will be re-squadded for singles only.

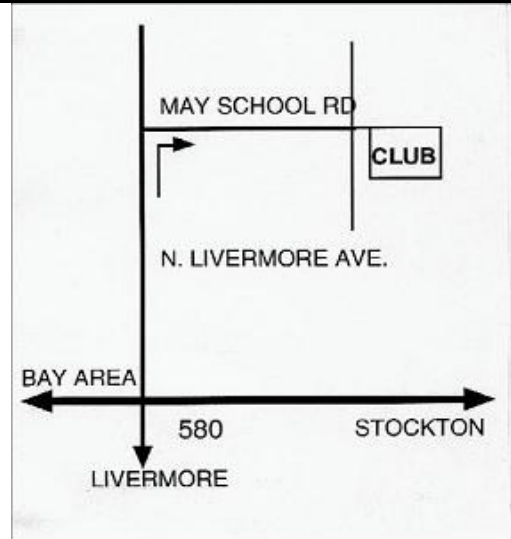

From 580 & 205

Take 580 West. Take the North Livermore Ave exit. At the bottom of the exit turn **RIGHT** and drive 2.6 miles. At May School Road turn **RIGHT** and drive 1.3 miles. At Dagnino Road, **STOP** and drive straight across into the Club.



Handicap Purses

Perpetual Purse

\$120.00

Winner must shoot 25 straight from any trap. In the event of a tie, payoff is divided among total number of shooters that shot one or more 25 straights.

Perfect 50's

\$291.00

Winner must shoot 50 straight at Handicap. Seventy-five percent (75%) of purse will be divided between the Perfect 50's participating at the shoot. To be eligible, you must have shot at least three times during the current and previous year.
