Pre-Squad info: If you are pre-squaded, when you arrive at a shoot, all you have to do is pickup your card from the table and proceed directly to the cashiers, no waiting to get squaded. A few days before a shoot you will receive an email about pre-squading. If you are going to attend, you do nothing. If you can't attend, then just reply back to the email that you can't attend. Very simple process and you will know where & who you will be shooting with at every shoot.
