When will the scores be posted on the website?

<u>Rules review:</u> It is the shooter's responsibility to verify and review their score for each post, and to assure the score sheet is clearly marked by the scorekeeper before it is submitted to the office. Scores for a post become final when the shooter shoots their first target at the next post, or (for the last post) when they leave the trap field. SBTL and ATA rules require that corrections be clearly labeled with the word 'DEAD', otherwise they are to be scored as a lost target.

Gun Safety is everyone's business.

Always be aware where your barrel is pointed. Please remember, when changing posts or changing traps, your guns should be open with nothing in the chambers.
