Since the singles format was so successful, we're planning on continuing with this approach for the rest of the SBTL events this year.

One other thing happened that helped speed up the whole sign-in process. Many people have chosen to "pre-squad" their attendance at the SBTL matches. If you're planning on shooting at least half of the matches, it is to your and our benefit that you get "pre-squadded." Just give us a call or send an e-mail for those events you won't be able to attend and we'll take care of it. Remember, those shooters who are "pre-squadded" pick up their cards and go directly to the cashier without having to stand in line at the handicap desk, which we think is a big benefit for all concerned.

Steve and Kerry would like to take this opportunity to thank all the individuals who helped with the organization and running of the Sunnyvale match. Without your contribution of time and knowledge, the SBTL would not be possible. Which brings up another point: SBTL is a totally volunteer organization. Nobody gets paid for their hours spent setting up the newsletter, establishing handicap yardages, developing squad positions, preparing the scoring sheets, collecting entrance fees, entering data, posting scores, running shoot-offs, or obtaining and handing out awards. We do all these things because we enjoy trap shooting and we want to make the SBTL experience enjoyable for as many participants as possible.

To win, the participant needs to shoot a 25 straight from any trap. In the event of a tie, the payoff is divided among the total number of 25's that are posted.

\$332.00

To win, the participant needs to shoot 50 straight at Handicap. Seventy-five percent (75%) of the purse, including the fees from that shoot, will be divided between the Perfect 50's participating at that shoot.

To play this purse, a shooter is required to have shot at least three (3) previous South Bay Trap League meets between the current and previous years.

Notes from the Shoot Office: Miscellaneous Stuff ...

First, the shoot office would like to quickly thank all the shooters that pre-squadded while at Sunnyvale. We had a huge batch that converted and anticipate that this will save time for everyone.

Those pre-squadded shooters can simply grab their card, review their handicap and assuming they have no questions, skip the handicapping and squadding lines and go straight to cashier where Glenn and Kirk will be happy to take your funds.

Between scorers and knowledgeable shooters, we saw that there were a batch of scoring corrections where "dead" was written in the scoring box. We are excited that we did not have to take away hard fought birds from shooters due to technical scoring errors. Keep up the good work.

We had one unfortunate issue crop up at the Sunnyvale shoot. We accidentally released an incorrect payout to an unidentified shooter on behalf of another shooter. SBTL has fixed the problem with that shooter, and we have changed our policy on who is allowed to pickup winnings for whom at the shoots. From Sunnyvale forward only the shooter, his/her spouse or parent may receive winnings from the bank. We apologize for the inconvenience that this might cause, but we need to make sure that everyone is handled equitably and that all winnings are disburse properly.

To all those shooters that were gracious enough to let us know that they would not be shooting with us in May, we extend a hearty THANK YOU!!!! It really helps us with pre-planning each shoot when we know who will be with us and who will not. Please remember, it is courteous to your fellow shooters to let us know when you are not shooting. It makes it easier for management to determine if we need to fill squads ahead of time as we cannot always easily do this at the last minute.

If you are pre-squadded and you plan to shoot, we don't ask you to do a thing. Just show up and shoot!

If you are pre-squadded and do not plan to shoot, please take advantage of one of the ways to contact us:

1. Wait until you receive our automated Pre-squad Reminder Notice a about a week before the shoot and "push the button",

3. Call us on our contact number.

While the office staff does everything that we can to ensure that all computer entries are made according to the instructions on the entry cards, **it is ultimately the shooter's responsibility to check their entries on the scoresheets.** As a reminder, these corrections can only be made before the end of the shoot. After the shoot, one is out of luck

Always be aware where your barrel is pointed. Please remember, when changing posts or changing traps, your guns should be open with nothing in the chambers.
